Dear Mr. Coleman,

Based upon the federal indicament of your client, former Pulaski County Municipal Judge David Hale, the Judicial Discipline & Disability Commission opened a case file. The first item to be considered was a recommendation to the Arkansas Supreme Court that Judge Hale be suspended from office pending resolution of the federal indicament. A conviction of any of the charges could have subsequently lead to his removal from office.

On September 24, 1993, Judge Hale submitted his immediate effective retirement to Governor Tucker. That same day Judge Hale agreed not to seek elective judicial office at any future time in the State of Arkansas.

In view of Judge Hale's withdrawal from judicial office and agreement not to seek future elective judicial office in the State of Arkansas, no further action appears necessary or appropriate in this case. This final action taken by the Commission is public information.
