*Dear Judge Jennings,*

*It was alleged that during the evening of March 7, 2000, on Highway 111, near the Pulaski/Saline Countyline, Arkansas, you were arrested and subsequently charged with driving while intoxicated. You refused both field sobriety and breathalyser tests. On August 3, 2000, you were found guilty of driving while intoxicated, in Bryant Municipal Court.*

*The Judicial Discipline and Disability Commission found your conduct on March 7, 2000 to be a wilful violation of Canons 1 and 2A of the Arkansas Code of Judicial Conduct. In view of these circumstances, it is the judgment of the Judicial Discipline and Disability Commission that you are hereby admonished.*
