Letter of Admonition*

Dear Judge Munson:

It was alleged that during the evening of June 9, 1999, on I-430 in Little Rock, Arkansas, you were arrested and subsequently charged with driving while intoxicated. Your blood-alcohol content at the time was .192. On July 27, 1999, pursuant to your plea, you were found guilty of driving while intoxicated.

At a probable cause hearing on September 17, 1999, the Judicial Discipline and Disability Commission reviewed the statement of allegations against you, and your testimony before the Commission. The Commission found your conduct on June 9, 1999 to be a wilful violation of Canons 1 and 2A of the Arkansas Code of Judicial Conduct. In view of these circumstances, it is the judgment of the Judicial Discipline and Disability Commission that you be admonished. The Commission will indulge in the expectation that this type of conduct will not be repeated.

This Commission action is public information.
